You will work closely with Zone and NNZ Community Netball teams and across all NNZ teams to ensure the effective integration and promotion of the programme across the Netball system.

To secure this position you will have a Physiotherapy or Sports Science background with specific knowledge of injury prevention and performance enhancing strategies. Broad sporting sector knowledge and experience from within the community sport arena in particular Netball is an advantage.

Strong stakeholder management and interpersonal skills that generate trust and respect must be a key strength along with experience developing strategies, planning, budgeting, analysis and communicating effectively with stakeholders.
