About NETBALL NEW ZEALAND

Netball New Zealand (NNZ), is the national governing body for Netball in New Zealand and has the responsibility for leading the development of the sport throughout New Zealand.

Netball has a proud tradition of widespread participation and sporting excellence from grassroots Netball through to the Silver Ferns. Through its role of developing and managing national programmes for participation, coaches, umpires and officials, NNZ aims for Netball to continue to be the first sport of choice for woman and girls in New Zealand. Netball New Zealand is supported by Netball's five zones and 83 Netball Centres who deliver the game to its 145,000 affiliated members and 350,000 plus people who participate in the game annually across New Zealand.

Role Summary

This is a key coaching role that requires working with the Silver Ferns Head Coach and National Player Development Manager to develop a performance environment and culture which produces athletes capable of winning at the international level. Working as part of the NNZ High Performance team, the Pathway Coach will lead the coaching and performance planning for national squads and teams immediately below the Silver Ferns (SFDS, NZA, NZU21, Fast5, P2P). This will include the role of head coach with at least one of these teams.

Knowledge, Skills and Experience

- Self-aware in the role, and understands their strengths and weaknesses
- Proven track record of Netball coaching success at ANZP level or equivalent
- Coaching qualifications and training that demonstrate elite coaching capability
- Strong collaborative leadership skills and experience with a high performing culture
- Extensive knowledge and experience in implementing player development across pathways
- Sound understanding of High Performance and what it takes to succeed as a High Performance coach
- Excellent relationship and interpersonal skills across a broad range of stakeholders

This is a contract role for a two year period. Initially the role will be 0.6FTE (3 days a week) with variable workflows through the year, but this may increase if the role requires.
