

#### **Sporty Platform**

New Sporty website platform is delivering results for Netball

As well as website the Sporty platform also provides you with:

- Social Integration use Facebook for quick updates
- Team Builder organise your members in to teams with easy drag-and-drop functionality
- Online Forms take registrations for the season, workshops or tournaments
- Online Payments take payments for fees, uniforms or workshops. Free set up and no ongoing monthly bills
- Newsletters create new content or information published on your website
- School Management Systems integrates easily allowing schools to use existing student information for Team Builder and player registrations









# **Sporty Platform Development**

NNZ Centre requested enhancements for 2017 included:

- 1. Ability to make contact fields mandatory when adding a team in TeamBuilder
- Enabled centres to require two mandatory contacts per team. In place for 2017 season
- 2. Ability to set the number of Contacts listed per Superform per team
- 3. Ability to export all team Contacts from TeamBuilder listed by Grade and Team per form

These two items are currently under development and will include the following:

- Introduction of additional Roles (key to the development of mobile app scoring)
- Role options able to be set per Superform.
- Minimum requirements can be set per role, including setting a minimum/maximum number of players per team
- Logged in view of TeamBuilder responsive for mobile
- Roles to appear as separate columns when exporting from TeamBuilder

The completion date of this development will be prior to the 2018 netball season.



#### SuperForms

- Easy solution for online registrations, allowing Centres, Clubs and Schools to set required information fields, collect information and payments
- Feedback from Centres using SuperForms
  - SuperForms saves around 20+ hours in managing player registrations each year (more for the larger, 5,000+ 'super centres')

  - Access to, and quality of information is hugely improved, enabling easy business reporting, funding applications and communications

- Significantly discounted pricing is available for all NNZ Centres



 Interested Centres will need to make themselves known by end of October for system to be set up for 2018 season.







### **KAMAR School Integration**

- Sportsground integrates with KAMAR one of the most popular School Management Systems (used in around 2/3 schools nationwide)
- The Sportsground system uses information in the school roll as a base for registrations, removing the need for manual data entry for key fields
- This allows schools to build their teams and complete registration by 'dragging and dropping' students from the school roll in to teams

NNZ does not release any member information to 3<sup>rd</sup> parties and communications will only come from NNZ as per the Communications Calendar




# **Centre Membership Reports**





With the creation of a centralised digital management solution for NNZ, we will be able to start creating Membership Reports for each Centre.
