## Schools and Clubs - Provide

<b>Participation opportunities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Providing the access and opportunity to participate in Netball.</li> <li>· Complete administrative processes and enter teams in competitions.</li> <li>· Build strong relationships and communication with members and Centres.</li> </ul>
<b>Development opportunities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Support and access development opportunities for players, managers, coaches' umpires, officials and volunteers.</li> </ul>
<b>Create positive, fair and an inclusive environment</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Create a positive, fair, and inclusive environment around all aspects of Netball.</li> <li>· Advocate on behalf of members for principles of fair play and equity.</li> </ul>
<b>Grow the game</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Attract and grow players, managers, coaches' umpires, officials, and volunteers to support the delivery of Netball.</li> <li>· Retain and grow participation.</li> <li>· Promote and enhance Netballs profile.</li> </ul>

## Centres - Deliver

<b>Programmes and Competition</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Deliver quality programmes and competitions that provide inclusive, accessible, and enjoyable participation opportunities and performance pathways that meet the needs of local communities.</li> <li>· Align with the Netball in New Zealand Strategy (Poipoiā) and its programmes and philosophies.</li> <li>· Provide fun, safe, and welcoming environments through implementation and compliance with national policies and guidelines.</li> <li>· Implement best practice governance within the Centre</li> </ul>
<b>Promotion, communication, and relationships</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Enhance the local profile of Netball.</li> <li>· Retention and growth of membership numbers.</li> <li>· Recognise and celebrate volunteers and Life Members.</li> <li>· Build strong relationships with Zones, local partners and funders, schools and clubs.</li> </ul>
<b>Training and Development</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Provide volunteer development and support.</li> <li>· Support player development through appropriate development programmes and representative teams.</li> <li>· Promote and support opportunities for player, coach, and umpire development within Centre or across clusters.</li> </ul>
<b>Facilities</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>· Maintain and provide high quality training and playing facilities as appropriate.</li> </ul>

## Zone - Enable

<b>Strategy, leadership, and relationships</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Provide Zone plan which aligns with the Netball in New Zealand strategy [Poipoi] as well as NNZ programmes and philosophies.</li> <li>Support development of Centre strategies and annual plans that align with the Netball in New Zealand strategy [Poipoi] and philosophies and meet the needs of Centres and their communities.</li> </ul>
<b>Promotion of the game</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Enhance Netball's profile across the Zone.</li> <li>Connect National Elite League/National Netball League athletes to the community game.</li> <li>Build strong relationships with local partners, funders and explore other partnership opportunities.</li> </ul>
<b>Support</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Support the implementation and compliance with national policies and guidelines.</li> <li>Support best practise governance at Centre level.</li> <li>Support the development of capable people, systems and processes through training as needed.</li> </ul>
<b>Programmes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Lead/support the coordination of delivery of programmes for players, coaches, officials and volunteers.</li> </ul>

## Netball New Zealand - Create

<b>Strategy, leadership, and relationships</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Strategic leadership of Netball in New Zealand, development of the national strategy [Poipoi] and its frameworks.</li> <li>Lead national funding and commercial relationships.</li> <li>Lead national level policies and connected education plans that underpin the integrity of the sport.</li> <li>Build strong international relationships with World Netball and other national entities.</li> </ul>
<b>Advocate and promote</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Advocate for Netball and women's sport.</li> <li>Deliver quality national tournaments, elite competitions and international events.</li> <li>Marketing and promotion of Netball in New Zealand, the Silver Ferns and the National Elite League.</li> </ul>
<b>Training and Development</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Training and professional development for the delivery network.</li> </ul>
<b>Programmes</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Research, develop and implement national programmes and resources for all participants.</li> <li>Select and manage national Netball teams.</li> </ul>
