Teams at the Netball New Zealand Under 18 Championships will play for the Margaret Forsyth Cup in memory of a Silver Fern great.

The Waikato shooter first made the headlines when gaining Silver Ferns selection in 1979, Margaret become Silver Fern #66 as a 17-yearold seventh former at Hillcrest High School. She played in netball's fourth world tournament in Trinidad & Tobago. The Silver Ferns finished in a three-way tie for top honours with the hosts and Australia.

Setting records that have stood for over 40 years, she remains the youngest Silver Fern to play at a Netball World Cup, while being just one of three Silver Ferns to win two world titles.

Of Ngāti Kahungunu ki Wairoa descent, Margaret embodied the values of being a key figure as a role model for young women, especially young Māori women.

For a player who achieved so much from a young age, it is a fitting tribute to the late Forsyth as well as providing a shining example for those who follow. Initially making her mark as a teenager, the dynamic and athletic shooter left an inspiring legacy following a dominant nine-year Silver Ferns career.

2025 Netball New Zealand Under 18 Championship – Women's Grade

DRAW NOTES

- 1. 35 teams entered
- 2. Initial section seeding based on 2024 Netball NZ U18 Champs final placings with note that;
 - a. Where there are more than two teams from one Zone the seeding has been managed with some team's seeding's altered with other teams.
 - b. Seeding movement is limited to no more than three positions.
 - c. Teams that did not compete in 2024 are at the bottom of each pool and are placed in pools under a managed process which may include geographic distribution or other factors.
 - d. Where teams have not entered in 2025 but played in 2024, all teams are moved up in seeding and reranked.
- 3. Initial pools 3 pools of 5 teams and 5 pools of 4 teams
 - a. Pools A, B, C, D, E 4 teams
 - b. Pool F, G & H 5 teams
- 4. Phase one round robin (3 or 4 games)
 - a. All teams play each other in their pool. Draws are permitted,
 - b. Monday and Tuesday All teams play 1 or 2 games in round robin on each day
 - c. At end of phase one pool play all teams are re-ranked based on position within their pool that is A1, A2, A3, A4, A5 etc.
- <u>Phase two</u> post-section play all teams are re-ranked based on their finishing position within their pool. No draws are permitted in this stage.
 - a. Top 16: 1st and 2nd place teams from each of the 8 pools (16 teams total)
 - b. Middle 16: 3rd and 4th place teams from each pool (16 teams total)
 - c. Bottom 3: 5th place teams (3 teams total)

2025 Netball New Zealand Under 18 Championship - Men's Grade DRAW NOTES

- 1. 9 teams entered
- 2. Initial section seeding based on 2024 Netball NZ U18 Champs final placings with note that;
 - a. Where there are two teams from one Centre, or more than two teams from one Zone, the seeding has been managed to limit overlap, with some teams moved up or down by no more than one position.
 - b. Teams new to the 2025 event have been placed at the bottom of their respective pools using a managed process, including consideration of geography and competitive balance.
- 3. Initial pools 2 pools
 - a. Pool A 5 teams
 - b. Pool B 4 teams
- 4. Phase one round robin (3 or 4 games)
 - a. All teams play each other in their pool. Draws are permitted.
 - b. Each team plays all other teams in their pool:
 - i. Pool A: 4 matches (10 games total)
 - ii. **Pool B**: 3 matches (6 games total)
 - c. Games are spread across Monday and Tuesday, with:
 - i. Pool A teams playing 2 games per day
 - ii. Pool B teams playing 1-2 games per day
 - d. Monday and Tuesday All teams play 1 or 2 games in round robin on each day
 - e. At end of phase one pool play all teams are re-ranked within their pools: A1–A5 and B1–B4.
