Teams at the Netball New Zealand U18 Champs will play for the Margaret Forsyth Cup in memory of a Silver Fern great.

The Waikato shooter first made the headlines when gaining Silver Ferns selection in 1979, Margaret become Silver Fern #66 as a 17-year-old seventh former at Hillcrest High School. She played in netball's fourth world tournament in Trinidad & Tobago. The Silver Ferns finished in a three-way tie for top honours with the hosts and Australia.

Setting records that have stood for over 40 years, she remains the youngest Silver Fern to play at a Netball World Cup, while being just one of three Silver Ferns to win two world titles.

Of Ngāti Kahungunu ki Wairoa descent, Margaret embodied the values of being a key figure as a role model for young women, especially young Māori women.

For a player who achieved so much from a young age, it is a fitting tribute to the late Forsyth as well as providing a shining example for those who follow. Initially making her mark as a teenager, the dynamic and athletic shooter left an inspiring legacy following a dominant nine-year Silver Ferns career.

Teams will also have compete for Plate and Bowl competitions as teams get split out for the final two days of the competition, whilst the Men's Grade will have a trophy of it's own.

1. 38 teams entered
2. Initial section seeding based on 2023 Netball NZ U18 Champs final placings with note that;
  - a. Where there are two teams from one Centre, or more than two teams from one Zone the seeding has been managed with some team's seeding's altered with other teams.
  - b. Seeding movement is limited to no more than three positions.
  - c. Teams that did not compete in 2023 are seeded at the bottom of each pool and are placed in pools under a managed process which may include geographic distribution or other factors.
  - d. Where teams have not entered in 2024 but played in 2023, all teams are moved up in seeding and re-ranked.
3. Initial pools – 6 pools of 5 teams and 2 pools of 4 teams
  - a. Pools A & H – 4 teams
  - b. Pools B, C, D, E, F & G – 5 teams
4. Phase **one** – **round robin** – (3 or 4 games)
  - a. All teams play each other in their pool. Draws are permitted,
  - b. Monday and Tuesday - All teams play 1 or 2 games in round robin on each day
  - c. At end of phase one pool play all teams are re-ranked based on position within their pool that is A1, A2, A3, A4, A5 etc.
5. **Phase two** - **Post-Section play** – **all teams are allocated into four groups – no draws are permitted in this stage**
  - a. Top two teams from each Section move into the TOP 16 – playing for 1st to 16th
  - b. Third and fourth placed teams from each section moves into the MIDDLE 16 – playing for 17th to 32<sup>nd</sup>
  - c. Fifth placed teams in each group that has five teams moves into the BOTTOM 6 – playing for 33th to 38th

#### **TOP 16 – 1st to 16th (4 games)**

- A1/A2/B1/B2/C1/C2/D1/D2/E1/E2/F1/F2/G1/G2/H1/H2
- **Wednesday am – play-offs top 16, Wednesday pm – Quarterfinals**
- **Thursday am – Semi-finals, Thursday pm – Final Play-offs**

#### **MIDDLE 16 – 17th to 32th (4 games)**

- A3/B3/C3/D3/E3/F3/G3/H3/A4/B4/C4/D4/E4/F4/G4/H4
- **Wednesday am – play-offs middle 16, Wednesday pm – Quarterfinals**
- **Thursday am – Semi-finals , Thursday pm – Final Play-offs**

#### **BOTTOM 6 – 32<sup>nd</sup> to 38<sup>th</sup> (3 games)**

- Two pools are formed – Group P – B5, C5, D5 Group Q - E5/F5/G5
- Each team plays two matches in group stage, before playing off on the final day for placings
- **33<sup>rd</sup> & 34<sup>th</sup> is played between P1 & Q1**
- **35<sup>th</sup> & 36<sup>th</sup> is played between P2 & Q2**
- **37<sup>th</sup> & 38<sup>th</sup> is played between P3 & Q3**

6. Teams will play a total of 7 or 8 games – this ranges depending on how many teams are in their pool and then which section of the competition they compete in the second stage
7. Teams will have a minimum of two rounds off in between games.

### **Men's Grade**

1. Six teams entered
2. All six teams will play a round-robin – playing each team throughout Monday to Wednesday – two games on two days and one on the other day.
3. The top four ranked sides will play in a semi-final on Wednesday afternoon, then on Thursday the winners of the semi-final will play off for the trophy, the losers of the semi-final will play for 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> whilst the 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> ranked sides from the group stage will play for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> on the Thursday.
4. Thursday will see the Finals played between M1 v M2, M3 v M4 and M5 v M6.
5. 5th and 6<sup>th</sup> ranked teams will play six matches, whilst the other four will play seven
6. Teams will have a minimum of two rounds off in between games.
